Mount Sequoyah Center 2017 Pool Policies

Because Mount Sequoyah Center Inc. has opened the pool to the general public, the pool is considered a public pool. To continue functioning in this way, Mount Sequoyah Center, Inc. must abide by specific rules and regulations regarding health, safety, and security at the pool.

Mount Sequoyah greatly appreciates the cooperation of all of our members and guests in adhering to these policies. If Mount Sequoyah fails to meet these rules and regulations, the organization will be forced to close the pool to the public. The following rules are in place to enable Mount Sequoyah to continue offering public memberships.

- When Lifeguards are NOT on duty, patrons swim at their own risk.
- Individuals may only enter the pool area during posted pool hours.
- Individuals MUST use the shower before entering the pool.
- Pets and animals are only allowed on the grassy area outside of the pool fence. Animals must be monitored at all times.
- Proper swimwear must be worn while in the pool. No street clothes, cutoffs, athletic shorts, biking tights, leotards or thongs. Swim diapers must be used by any children still in diapers.
- Food, drinks, and chewing gum are only allowed outside the designated pool area. Glass containers are strictly prohibited.
- Only Lifeguards are allowed on the lifeguard stand at any time.
- An adult (18 years or older) MUST accompany children 7 years of age and under in the pool. An adult MUST accompany children 8-13 years of age in the pool area.
- Running, dunking, unnecessary splashing and/or horseplay are strictly prohibited.
- Only music devices with personal headphones are allowed in the pool area.
- All trash shall be disposed of in the proper trash/recycling bins.
- Persons with open sores or cuts or evidence of disease will not be allowed in the pool. If the wound is open enough to require a bandage, the patron is NOT allowed to swim.
- NO diving from pool deck at any time.
- NO running on pool deck at any time.
- Patrons must exit the pool deck during any bad or threatening weather and seek shelter elsewhere. Swimming may resume 30 minutes after the last sight and sound of thunder or lightning.
- Tobacco products, drug use, alcoholic beverages, and weapons are strictly prohibited.
- Head lifeguard and/or lifeguards have final authority at the pool, and guests and members will comply with requests.
- Appropriate wristbands must be worn inside the pool at all times.
- Key cards are non-transferrable and are to be used as programmed. Guest passes may be purchased in the office.
- Breath holding and prolonged submersion is not permitted for safety reasons. *Ex. Breath holding contest*

I agree to abide by the swimming pool rules listed above and as amended at any future date. I understand that I assume all risks when I, or another guest in my party, use the Mount Sequoyah swimming pool and pool area. I understand that I am responsible for the behavior of all parties in my reservation. I agree to indemnify and hold harmless Mount Sequoyah Center, Inc. from any and all liability for any injury or damage while using the Mount Sequoyah Swimming Pool. I understand that the area is under video surveillance and that my actions will be monitored for the overall safety of everyone using the area.
